Windows® XP/Vista OS

By default, the primary display adapter is set to the graphics card.

To set the onboard VGA/HDMI port as the primary display adapter:

1. Connect your monitor to the graphics card.
2. Boot the system and press **** during the Power-On Self-Test (POST) to enter the BIOS setup program.
3. Go to **Advanced > Chipset**. Set the **Primary Display Adapter** item to **[Onboard]** and **Onboard GPU** to **[Always Enable]**.
4. Press **<F10>** to save the changes, then the system reboots.
5. Disconnect your monitor from the graphics card, then connect it to the onboard VGA/HDMI port during the system reboot process.
